PARIS, May 31.—The Mayor of Vendome and the Secretary of the Rochambeau Committee have telegraphed to United States Ambassador Porter as follows: "We beg your Excellency to accept this expression of our respectful good wishes, which we address to the American people. We address to the American people and their distinguished representative in France patriotic and fraternal greetings. The people of Vendome are preparing to warmly welcome those Americans who will be pleased to honor them by their presence at the fêtes attending the unveiling of the Rochambeau Monument next Monday. Honor to Washington, to Lafayette, to Rochambeau, to de Grasse! Vive la France, the United States, and the republic!"
