PARIS, March 31.—An interesting little Franco-American demonstration took place this week in the town of Vendome, which forms a further indication of the way the wind blows here in favor of America. Vendome is the home of the Rochambeau family, and a subscription was recently raised for the erection of a monument to the Marquis de Rochambeau. The first stone was laid early in the week and a message of fraternity was sent to President McKinley. The committee to-day received a reply, saying the President was deeply touched by the sentiments of cordial fraternity for the United States.
